INVITATION TO PRESENT

We invite you to deliver one of the following types of presentation at the conference:

- 10 minute commercial presentation on new products or processes – not limited to, but generally taken up by exhibitors and sponsors
- 25 minute technical presentation

We are flexible and welcome any suggestion you may have for the format of your presentation. Any given presentation should not be longer than 25 minutes.

The 10-minute presentations are usually presented together as a block session.

The 25-minute presentations can be heard by all interested delegates and are arranged in chaired groups of topics.

These sessions are not to be a straight advertising presentation for your company or product but to focus on the technology developments or the use/benefits in the winery of the product/process. Your company/product will be acknowledged in both the conference proceedings book and by the chair of the session.

The final choice regarding which presentations are chosen will depend on relevance to the conference theme, this year being **‘Supporting Innovation in Winemaking’**, other selection criteria will include whether you have recently presented, ‘newness’ of product/process/technology and the conference timetable.

SPEAKER REGISTRATION

Registration as a speaker is done by returning the SPEAKER REGISTRATION form at the end of this document as soon as possible. That will ensure that your presentation is considered for selection onto the program.

To complete the registration process we require the following information by the 16th April 2010:

1. Provide a brief 150 to 250-word summary of your presentation. This will be printed in the conference book and included on the proceedings CD. It can include pictures but should preferably be in MSWord format and e-mailed to djc2@bigpond.com
2. Provide a brief professional biography of the speaker. This will also be printed in the conference book, included on the proceedings CD, and used by your session chairperson. It should preferably be in MSWord format and e-mailed to djc2@bigpond.com.

SPEAKER BENEFITS

Speakers (with the exception of those making 10 minute commercial presentations) are not required to register for the conference nor pay the entrance fees; they also have free attendance at the conference dinner. Any persons assisting a speaker must register as a delegate and pay the fees if they wish to attend the conference dinner.

Speakers who are also sponsors or exhibitors shall be subject to the same conditions as any other sponsor or exhibitor. Please check these with Trevor Leighton.
